The Post Anesthetic Care Unit (PACU) at the St Joseph's Hospital site is a 16 bay unit providing recovery following surgery for our ophthalmology, urology, upper limb orthopedics, plastics, ENT and interventional radiology populations. In addition to providing post-surgery care, the PACU supports Step-Up capacity for inpatients requiring a higher level of care and the PACU nurses are members of the Medical Emergency Response Team for the facility. The PACU provides care to our inpatients on weekends. The successful candidate will be a Registered Nurse with adult critical care experience. This may include labour/delivery room, emergency department, CCU/ CCU (cardiac care.), strong surgical experience and/or direct PACU (recovery room) experience. The successful candidate will have excellent critical thinking and problem solving skills and thrive as a member of an interdisciplinary team.
