The ideal candidate has expert knowledge of recovery and trauma informed care; is skilled in de-escalation and supporting prevention of crisis situations, can facilitate clinical problem solving and role model effective interpersonal relationship skills. The Nurse Educator will provide educational support (including orientation and ongoing education) to staff and students, as well as support program development, research and quality initiatives and change management.
