Reporting to the Coordinator of Facilities Engineering, the Carpenter is accountable for the structural and architectural buildings systems, including millwork installation, installation of modular furniture, hardware, lock keying, glazing, floor surfaces, steel and wood framing, interior and exterior finishes, taping and mudding, installs doors, windows, builds stairs, lay flooring, erects scaffolding, installs suspended ceilings, constructs concrete, builds framework and other duties as required. Duties will also include providing estimates of labour and materials content for minor projects and renovations. The incumbent will work collaboratively with other trade groups and disciplines in completing work requests.
