As a member of the Hand and Upper Limb Clinic Physiotherapy Team, the successful candidate will be a valued member caring for predominantly ambulatory patients with acute and/or complex musculoskeletal orthopaedic conditions of the upper extremity. Additionally, the candidate will also be part of the WSIB Specialty Clinic Team and will provide comprehensive assessments and treatment recommendations within the WSIB Shoulder and Elbow Specialty Clinic. Patients /workers with conditions which include, but are not limited to tendon injuries/reconstructions, peripheral nerve injuries, fractures, dislocations and traumatic injuries to the upper extremity. In a supportive learning environment, the successful candidate would also participate in other opportunities such as program development and evaluation, research activities and student mentorship.

The successful candidate will also be expected to provide some weekend physiotherapy care to the acute inpatient population.

- Experience working with acute post surgical and/or chronic musculoskeletal conditions, and demonstrate knowledge and experience with surgical and non surgical conditions related to the shoulder.
