The Pre-Surgical Screening Unit is a specialized clinic that provides a streamlined approach to the preoperative assessment of patients requiring surgery. The clinic has up to 200 visits per week comprised of both in person and telephone calls between the hours of 0800 and 1800.

The pre-admission nurse is responsible to ensure that patients receive a comprehensive assessment and plan to meet patient and family needs. The nurse ensures that the patient is well informed about the surgical experience including the appropriate health teaching and post operative care requirements.
