The successful candidate will work under the direction of Dr. Forchuk in the role of the "Research Coordinator". This position will assist the Department of Mental Health Nursing in the conduct of research studies under the Principal Investigator. Responsibilities include managing the daily operations of research projects from study set-up to closeout; budget management; invoice preparation; ensuring accurate collection of, and properly secured data; quantitative data analysis; and general office duties and administrative support. Preparation and updating CIHR CVs; research proposals; research ethics board applications and revisions; grant applications; manuscripts and submission of project abstracts is also required. Other responsibilities include coordinating meetings, preparing agendas, recording and distributing minutes, arranging room bookings and catering, and ensuring staffing support.

This role liaises with patients, research staff, and external stakeholders in the conduct of research studies while ensuring compliance with the research study protocols, research policies and regulatory requirements.

- Demonstrated ability to collaborate, develop and maintain effective relationships within healthcare teams
