The role of Senior Storekeeper includes material handling, order consolidation, shipping and receiving, and driving a 26' commercial vehicle with an automatic transmission and lift gate. Driving assignments are both in city and throughout the region. The employer will provide training and certification for operation of a Class 1 Counter Balance, Class 2 Reach Truck and/or Class 3.

- Valid Class G Driver's License and demonstrated ability to operate a 26' or greater commercial vehicle with an automatic transmission
