Position requirements include: supporting the Therapeutic Recreation Specialists in varying recreational programming and tasks, assisting with centralized therapeutic activities and events, working with their assigned teams to regularly engage with patients and assisting teams in planning, running and preparing activities and events both on the units or off the units as assigned. Other duties as assigned may include: escorting patients to and from services, assisting patients in off ward passes and preparing security bracelets for same; assist patients and visitors with wayfinding to and from appointments.
