The Nurse Educator will provide educational support (including orientation and ongoing education) to staff and students as well as support program development, research and quality initiatives and change management. The Nurse Educator will also play a role in supporting regional education and training efforts with partners across the region, including Behavioural Supports Ontario staff. Occasional travel within Southwestern Ontario may be required.
