Primary sources of data managed by QM&CDS include the Patient Safety Reporting System, Resident Assessment Instruments, the National Rehabilitation Reporting System, and Workload Measurement System, as well as the provincial Case Costing System and Wait Time Information System (WTIS).

As a Decision Support Intern in QM&CDS, this role will work in a team environment with QM&CDS Consultants and Specialists. You will support data quality and audit priorities for QM&CDS-managed systems as well as test plans for system upgrades and enhancements. The successful applicant will participate in analytics development projects with other team members as well as regular analysis and report preparation and will also be involved in care experience survey processes.
