An exciting opportunity exists for a Registered Practical Nurse (RPN) to provide services within an interprofessional team within the Hand and Upper Limb Centre (HULC) of St. Joseph's Health Care, London. HULC is a combined Orthopaedic and Plastic Surgery unit specializing in the care of patients with disorders of the upper limb. Patients with all disorders of the shoulder, elbow, wrist and hand are seen, including those due to congenital anomalies, trauma, arthritis and tumors.

The RPN in the Hand and Upper Limb Clinic is part of the care team which includes physicians, medical residents, registered nurses and an orthopedic technician. Working in a fast paced environment, this RPN will practice at his/her full scope of practice that will include basic casting, cast removal, brace fitting, wound care and management, etc.
