An exciting opportunity exists for a registered occupational therapist to work in the inpatient programs across Parkwood Institute Main. Parkwood Institute Main inpatient programs provide medical management, slow stream and high intensity rehabilitation, and complex continuing care to adults of all ages following a major medical event, accident, illness, or an age-related functional decline.

The primary assignment of this role will include Short-Term Medically Complex Care, Geriatric Rehab, and Musculoskeletal Rehab.

The short-term Medically Complex Care program supports individuals who require specialized slow stream rehabilitation after a medical event or illness with the goal to optimize function, independence and quality of life for a safe transition to the next level of rehabilitative care or discharge to a community setting.

Geriatric Rehab serves older adults with age-related medical, functional and cognitive decline and prioritizes optimization of independence and quality of life.

Musculoskeletal Rehab provides care to adults of all ages, with a focus on restoring function, improving quality of life and reducing pain.

Our interdisciplinary teams provide holistic and collaborative care.

As a member of the Parkwood Institute Main Integrated Allied Coverage team, you will demonstrate expertise in providing occupational therapy care and services, including assessment, treatment, discharge planning and community liaison for adults of all ages with a variety of complex medical, physical, functional and cognitive conditions.

- Experience and demonstrated competency in establishing rehabilitation goals and evidence-based treatment plans
- Knowledge of a Safety Culture in a Health Care Setting in compliance with the OHSA

- Understanding of palliative and end of life care
- Familiarity with outcome measurement related to clinical practice
- Knowledge of community resources for patients being discharged.
