As a member of the occupational health and safety team, the Health and Safety, Practical Nurse will be responsible for the health of all workers through prevention, recognition, and treatment of illness and injury with the use of special skills and knowledge in the fields of health, education, environmental health and human relations. Key responsibilities will include administering the Pre-Employment Health Review process, ongoing surveillance, respiratory protection, immunizations, and programs associated with influenza and COVID-19 prevention/management.

The Health and Safety, Practical Nurse contributes to the ongoing development and provision of evidenced based, best practice in the delivery of our occupational health program. Working in a multidisciplinary team, this role supports staff health and wellbeing, disability management, safety, and infection prevention. The successful candidate is an experienced and enthusiastic influencer who brings energy to work and relationships, has a passion for customer service and builds community among teams they serve.

The successful candidates will work at SJHC or Parkwood and may be required to work at the alternate site to cover vacations.
