This role represents the organization through direct interaction with patients, insurance companies, 3rd party service providers and the Ontario Ministry of Health regarding billing and payment inquiries in person and over the phone. The position requires availability to work at business offices at St. Joseph's Hospital, Mount Hope, Parkwood Institute, Parkwood Institute Finch Family Mental Health Care, and Southwest Centre for Forensic Mental Health Care in St. Thomas.
