The program includes medical management, exercise program, and access to a dietitian and social worker.

The Kinesiologist in the Cardiac Rehabilitation and Secondary Prevention Program is responsible for implementing and coordinating individualized patient care plans through healthy lifestyle change and exercise prescription encouraging patients in maintaining and optimizing function and self-management through exercise, training and consultation.
