A variety of clinical areas have positions available for Clinical Extern (nursing).

Reporting to the Professional Practice Partnership Program, the Clinical Extern (nursing) will work part-time hours to a maximum of full-time hours (37.5 hours per week). The scheduling of these hours will be determined based on organizational needs and may include day/evening/night and weekend shifts.
