- Experience with the Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP) and proficiency in using the BI-RADS (Breast Imaging Reporting and Data System).
- Strong understanding of breast cancer pathology and related treatment pathways.
- Advanced knowledge and skills relating to the assessment, management, and evaluation of treatment plans for breast patient populations.
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and as an effective member of an interdisciplinary team.
- Experience in program development, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office and electronic medical records; experience with EMR systems is an asset.
- Superior interpersonal, coaching, and communication skills to effectively work within clinic settings.
- Membership in RNAO, NPAO, and CNPS with professional liability insurance.
- Competent in Clinical Breast Exam (CBE).
- Experience in collaborative and independent research.
