You will be responsible for identifying and resolving drug related problems. Additionally, this position allows for a unique opportunity to assist providers with medication reconciliation at admission. You will work with residents/patients and their families to provide care, to assist and support them, meet their evident and anticipated needs, and enhance their quality of life. You will be a drug information resource and provide input on drug formulary and drug utilization issues. You will be responsible for order verification for your program. Additionally, you will have some responsibility for the main dispensary and coverage of other programs. Our department offers many professional development opportunities, such as student education, research, and pharmacist continuing education.
