Key aspects of the role would include facilitating clinical problem solving, development of program processes to support clinical practices, as well as role modeling effective interpersonal relationship skills. The Nurse Educator will provide educational support (including orientation and ongoing education) to staff and students as well as support program development, research and quality initiatives and change management. The Nurse Educator will also play a role in supporting regional education and training efforts with partners across the region, including Long Term Care, and Behavioural Supports Ontario staff. Travel within Southwestern Ontario is required.
