Serving southwestern Ontario, the Centre for Diabetes, Endocrinology and Metabolism is a teaching program affiliated with Western University, the Lawson Health Research Institute and the Robarts Research Institute.

The Registered Dietitian (Certified Diabetes Educator) works collaboratively with the interprofessional team to provide client-centred evidenced based and coordinated diabetes education, insulin adjustment and insulin pump management to patients with diabetes referred by endocrinologists and family physicians. The dietitian will use skills in individual and group-based nutrition education to facilitate the provision of client-focused diabetes care.

- Ability to successfully complete the insulin adjustment certification upon completion of 750 hours worked and/or no later than one year of employment

- Demonstrated expertise in developing and implementing nutritional care plans
- Demonstrated knowledge of current evidence-based practice related to diabetes, including pathophysiology, nutritional strategies, and self-care management
- Knowledge of community resources and the ability to assist patients and families to navigate the health care system.
- Knowledge of education theory (including adult learning principles) and demonstrated experience in the development of diabetic teaching materials and the teaching and education of patients (and family/caregivers)
